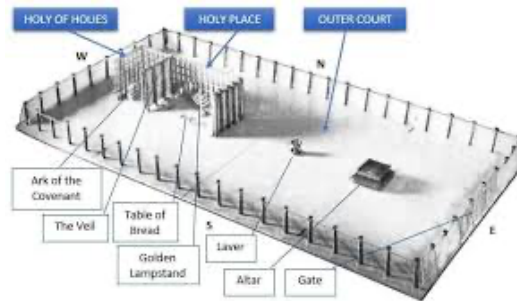

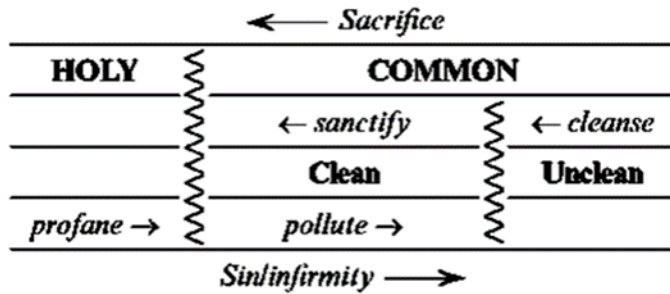
Leviticus 10:1-3 NASB95 - 1 Now Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, took their respective firepans, and after putting fire in them, placed incense on it and offered strange fire before the LORD, which He had not commanded them. 2 And fire came out from the presence of the LORD and consumed them, and **they died** before the LORD. 3 Then Moses said to Aaron, "It is what the LORD spoke, saying, 'By those who come near Me I will be treated as holy, And before all the people I will be honored.'" So Aaron, therefore, kept silent.

Leviticus 16:1-2 - 1 Now the LORD spoke to Moses after the death of the two sons of Aaron, when they had approached the presence of the LORD and died. 2 The LORD said to Moses: "Tell your brother Aaron that he shall not enter at any time into the holy place inside the veil, before the mercy seat which is on the ark, **or he will die**; ...

Leviticus 10:8-11 NASB95 - 8 **The LORD then spoke to Aaron**, saying, 9 "Do not drink wine or strong drink, neither you nor your sons with you, when you come into the tent of meeting, **so that you will not die** it is a perpetual statute throughout your generations 10 and **so as to make a distinction between the holy and the profane, and between the unclean and the clean,** 11 and so as to teach the sons of Israel all the statutes which the LORD has spoken to them"

Exodus 19:5-6 NASB95 - 5 'Now then, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be My own possession among all the peoples, for all the earth is Mine; 6 and you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.' These are the words that you shall speak to the sons of Israel."

Leviticus 11:44-45 NASB95 - 44 'For I am the LORD your God. Consecrate yourselves therefore, and be holy, for I am holy. And you shall not make yourselves unclean with any of the swarming things that swarm on the earth. 45 'For I am the LORD who brought you up from the land of Egypt to be your God; thus you shall be holy, for I am holy.'



- Leviticus 11:1-8, 46-47 Distinguishing between clean and unclean animals
- Leviticus 12:7-8 Cleansing after childbirth
- Leviticus 13:45-46 Distinguishing skin (and other surface) diseases as unclean
- Leviticus 14:1-3 Cleansing skin (and house) diseases
- Leviticus 15:31-33 Diagnosing and cleansing of unclean bodily discharges

Mark 7 14 ... "Listen to Me, all of you, and understand: 15 there is nothing outside the man which can defile him if it goes into him; but the things which proceed out of the man are what defile the man. 16 .. His disciples questioned Him about the parable. 18 And He said to them, "Are you so lacking in understanding also? Do you not understand that whatever goes into the man from outside cannot defile him, 19 because it does not go into his heart, but into his stomach, and is eliminated?" ([Thus He] declared all foods clean.) 20 And He was saying, "That which proceeds out of the man, that is what defiles the man. 21 "For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed the evil thoughts, fornications, thefts, murders, adulteries, 22 deeds of coveting [and] wickedness, [as well as] deceit, sensuality, envy, slander, pride [and] foolishness. 23 "All these evil things proceed from within and defile the man."

Acts 10:9-37 NASB95 - ... 13 A voice came to him, "Get up, Peter, kill and eat!" 14 But Peter said, "By no means, Lord, for I have never eaten anything unholy and unclean." 15 Again a voice [came] to him a second time, "What God has cleansed, no [longer] consider unholy." 16 This happened three times, 28 And he said to them, "You yourselves know how unlawful it is for a man who is a Jew to associate with a foreigner or to visit him; and [yet] God has shown me that I should not call any man unholy or unclean. 34 Opening his mouth, Peter said: "I most certainly understand [now] that God is not one to show partiality, 35 but in every nation the man who fears Him and does what is right is welcome to Him.
