Biblical Principles regarding Spiritual Gifts;

- The purpose of the gifts is to serve **one another**, not **self**. (1 Pet. 4:10; 1 Cor. 12:7; Eph. 4:12)
- Spiritual Gifts are often categorized as gifts of **speaking** and **servicing**. (1 Pet. 4:10-11)
- Every believer is given at least one Spiritual gift. (Eph. 4:7; 1 Pet. 4:10; 1 Cor. 12:7, 11)

Description of Certain Gifts:

- Apostle – Restricted to those who have seen the risen Lord and were commissioned by Him. (
- Prophecy - receiving direct revelation from God and communicating that message in a perfect inspired way. - Jack Hughes
- Distinguishing of spirits – discerning truth from error (Acts 16:16ff)
- Tongues –the ability to speak a foreign language that had not been learned by the speaker – John MacArthur
