9:1-5 Possess the Land

vv. 1-3 Strong Enemies, Stronger God

vv. 4-5 Basis for Possessing the Land

- Wickedness of Canaan
- **NOT** because of Your Righteousness
- Promises of God

9:6 – 24 Exhibit Hall of Unrighteousness

vv. 8-21 Incident at Horeb

vv. 22-24 Four Other Examples

(cf. Num.11:1-3; Ex. 17; Num. 11:31-35; Num. 13-14)

Summary: “You have been rebellious against the Lord from the day that I knew you.” (v.24)

vv. 25 – 29 Moses Intercedes, God Forgives

- Aaron’s Death and Succession of Eleazar as Priest (v. 6)

vv. 10-11 Moses’ Prayer Answered

- A Merciful God: “The Lord was unwilling to destroy you”.
